The product you have purchased is NOT designed for home DIY fitting. You are required under the Terms of the Warranty to have the unit fitted by a professional plumber/bathroom fitter.

The unit also requires connection to mains electricity, which will require a qualified electrician with Part P certification.

Ensure your fitter thoroughly checks the shower tray for leaks before commencing installation and that the unit does not leak after. You must also check all functions are fully operational.

Some hose connections are made for transportation purposes only, so all connections will need to be checked and tightened before installation is complete.

All Springwave Showers require a balanced water pressure of at least 1 bar and a flow rate of at least 7.5 litres per minute.

All Springwave showers are designed to be free standing. You must ensure that you are able to gain access to the rear of the unit to inspect or attend the hoses and electrical connections should the need arise. We will consequently not be liable for costs incurred by fitters needing to fit replacement parts on units that are fastened to the fabric of the property, sealed in, boxed in or otherwise installed into modified or awkward access locations.
